Application Information

The Process

On receipt of your application the Honorary Secretary will read out your details to the Board of the Club. The Board meets once a month. Should there be no objections during the following weeks your application will be a read a second time at the following Board meeting.

Following this your application form will be posted on the member's notice board for two weeks to allow further consideration by interested members.

Should there be no objections your application will be processed. You will be invoiced for your membership. On receipt of your full joining and annual fees you will then be deemed to be a member of the club.

The process takes between six and ten weeks.

If you do not know a member to propose you please do not give up. Contact the General Manager, we will discuss your application and see how we can help.

Objections

At the reading to the Board there needs to be 2 objectors to have the candidates application refused.

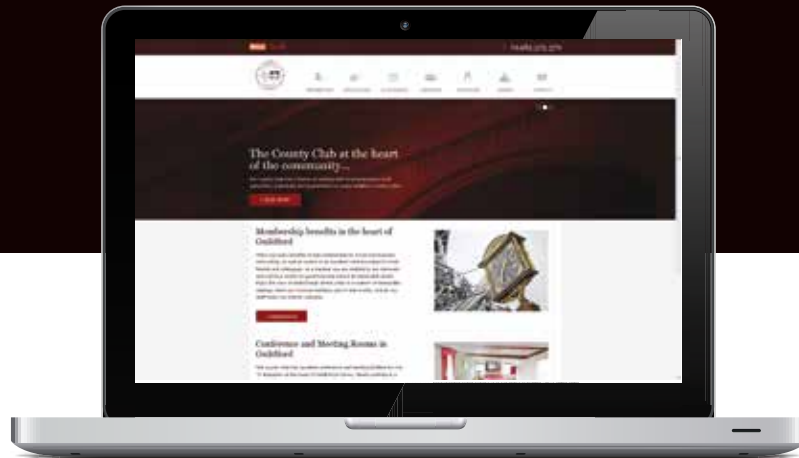
Whilst the application is on the Members Notice Board if there is just one objection from a member then the candidates application must be referred back the Board for consideration.
